First contact physiotherapist

The musculoskeletal (MSK) practitioner is a physiotherapist with enhanced skills. She helps patients with issues such as back, neck and joint pain by:

- assessing and diagnosing issues
- giving expert advice on how best to manage conditions
- referring patients onto specialists

Patients using the service have quicker access to diagnosis and treatment, helping them to manage their conditions more effectively and recover faster, so they can get back to normal life quickly.

Patients can be booked in with the MSK Specialist by speaking to the practice receptionist.

If you have visited a hospital as an in-patient, outpatient or day-case patient and require medication on discharge, it is the hospital's responsibility to provide as a minimum the first 7 days of your medication.

We are highlighting this so patients know to ask about their medication prior to leaving the hospital.

Changes made by the Surgery

The installation and set-up of the new phone system was a smooth transition. Almost instantaneously the difference to the phone line and the improvement for staff and patients being able to get through was noted. Many patients have used the "call back" facility meaning they are not held in a queue; patients also know exactly where they are in the queue.

To support the increase in demand the practice has increased the amount of clinical appointments by 256 appointments per month since the Covid Pandemic.

George Campbell Leisure Centre Exercise Referral Scheme

The Exercise Referral Scheme is a 12-week programme for people who have been referred by a health professional. The aim of the scheme is to improve your health and lifestyle, meet new people and have fun and enjoy yourself.

Medical conditions that can be helped by exercise include: diabetes, high blood pressure, osteoporosis, obesity, stress, asthma, joint and muscle injuries and angina.

You can exercise at ANYTIME – swimming, gym, exercise classes including Pilates, Yoga or chair based.

There is no joining fee and the cost is only £26.70 per month.
